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VI. APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the State Construction Act of 1972, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, being Section 125.1523a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. VIII. FEE CLARIFICATIONS

ITEM #2, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITES: WHEN item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. WHEN setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

IX. PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

Have plans been submitted? (See below for plan review requirements before completing this section.) YES NO NOT REQUIRED

Plans are not required for the following:

1. One and two-family dwelling containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
2. Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature.
3. Assembly, Business, Mercantile, and Storage buildings with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12.
4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

If work being performed is described above, answer Section IV. **“Not required.”**

Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal. **PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.**

X. SPECIAL INSPECTION INCLUDES 1- INSPECTION AND 1- REPORT.

XI. REINSPECTION FEE

1. All inspections found to be in violation are subject to a \$40.00 reinspection fee.
2. If the inspector finds a violation with the permit holders' project, the inspector must inform the permit holder.
3. The inspector will leave a copy of the inspection form on the project site stating the violation.
4. After the permit holder has corrected the violation, the permit holder must call the Building Department to schedule a reinspection.
5. If the project remains incorrect, an additional reinspection fee will be charged.

XII. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for the permit has been filed with the Building Department. Non-compliance will result in a \$65.00 charge minimum. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** The name of the inspector and the telephone number will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and the permit number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF PERVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REINSTATED OR REFUNDED.**
